Where Freedom Flows

Enjoy a Free, Open-air Gallery on the Waterfront

Experience a curated lineup of immersive exhibitions and installations along the Waterfront spanning Cherry Street Pier to Spruce Street Harbor Park.

Let Freedom Ring by Paul Ramírez Jones

JUNE 4 - SEPTEMBER 27, CHERRY STREET PIER

Strike a 600-pound bell tower to sound the final note of “My Country, ‘Tis of Thee”. In partnership with Association for Public Art.

Sail Through This To That by Indira Allegra

MAY 28 - JULY 30, PENN'S LANDING MARINA AND SPRUCE STREET HARBOR PARK

A celebration of life, this large-scale artwork follows the waters of the Delaware River and is highlighted by triptych of sewn sails on North Wind schooner, docked at Spruce Street Harbor Park. In partnership with Art Philly and funded by The Pew Center for Arts & Heritage.

2026 DRWC Flag Exhibition: Roots of Resilience

MAY 22 - SEPTEMBER 7, SPRUCE STREET HARBOR PARK

Explore flag designs from national and international artists that explore Philadelphia's history as a central immigration hub in the United States.

PrismaPhonik by William Simard and Anthony Gagnon Boisvert

JUNE 26 - AUGUST 17, SPRUCE STREET HARBOR PARK

A “magical stroll in the heart of a symphony orchestra,” this installation consists of luminous colorful prisms, allowing visitors to experience synesthesia, the ability to see sounds in color.

Colmado del Futuro by Eunice Levis

JUNE 5 – JULY 26, CHERRY STREET PIER

Take in an immersive, mixed-reality art installation reimagining a traditional Caribbean corner store as a futuristic gathering space. Rooted in Dominican and Afro-Caribbean cultural memory, the work blends physical installation, projection mapping, sound design and interactive storytelling.

Wings and Water: The Space Between by GrioXArts

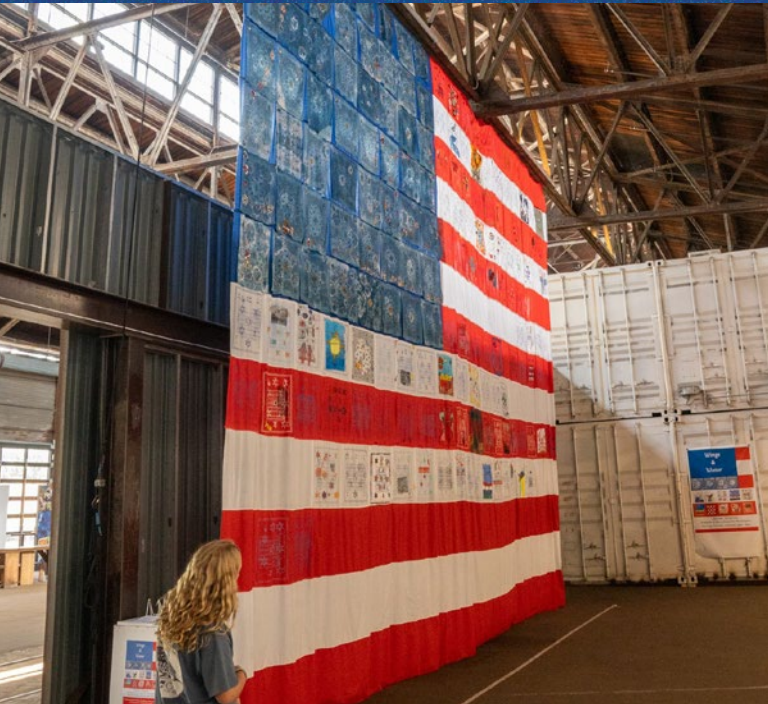
JULY 3 – AUGUST 1, CHERRY STREET PIER

This community-driven art installation explores themes of freedom, fluidity, and collective identity through textile-based storytelling. The centerpiece is a large-scale “flagspace”, recreating an American flag composed of hand-embroidered bandanas created during public workshops. In partnership with MSAC.

Sonia Shiel: Solo Exhibition

AUGUST 7 – 30, CHERRY STREET PIER

This site-specific, iterative exhibition will be one of three locations on the east coast. The paintings and materials in the exhibition will include nautical sensibilities related to the Delaware River Waterfront.

Slow down at Race Street Pier and soak in the incredible views, set up a picnic, or exercise your body and mind with yoga.

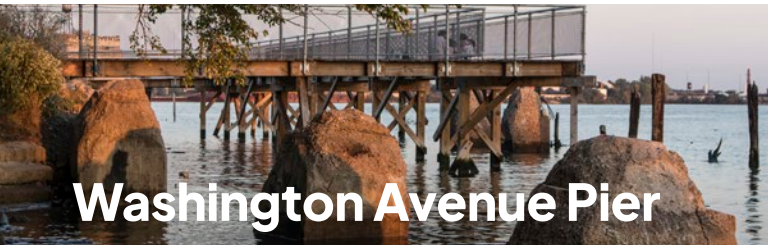

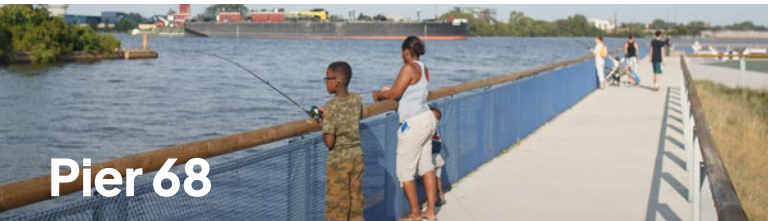

Know Before You Go

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Philly PHLASH

Daily service from May 22 – September 7, 10am–6pm
The PHLASH bus stop is located at the corner of 2nd St. and Market St., just a short walk to the Waterfront.

SEPTA Market–Frankford Line

The 2nd Street station is a 5–minute walk to the Waterfront.

Septa Bus Routes

Routes 5, 12, 17, 21, 25, 33, 38, 42, 44, and 48 all provide convenient drop-off locations at the Waterfront.

BY FERRY

Daily Service from May 22 – September 7
Saturday to Sunday Service from September 12 – 27
The RiverLink Ferry connects the Camden Waterfront to the Philadelphia Waterfront.

BY CAR

Parking may be limited, so we encourage you to plan ahead or take taxi or rideshare services. If you drive, visit ArriveattheWaterfront.com for a list of parking options.

BY BIKE

Use the two-lane biking path available via the Delaware River Trail, which runs along Columbus Boulevard from Pier 70 in South Philadelphia to Penn Treaty Park in Fishtown.

BY FOOT

The Waterfront is accessible by foot via South Street, Spruce Street, Dock Street, Market Street, Race Street, and Washington Avenue, all connecting with Columbus Blvd. You can also walk along the Delaware River Trail.
