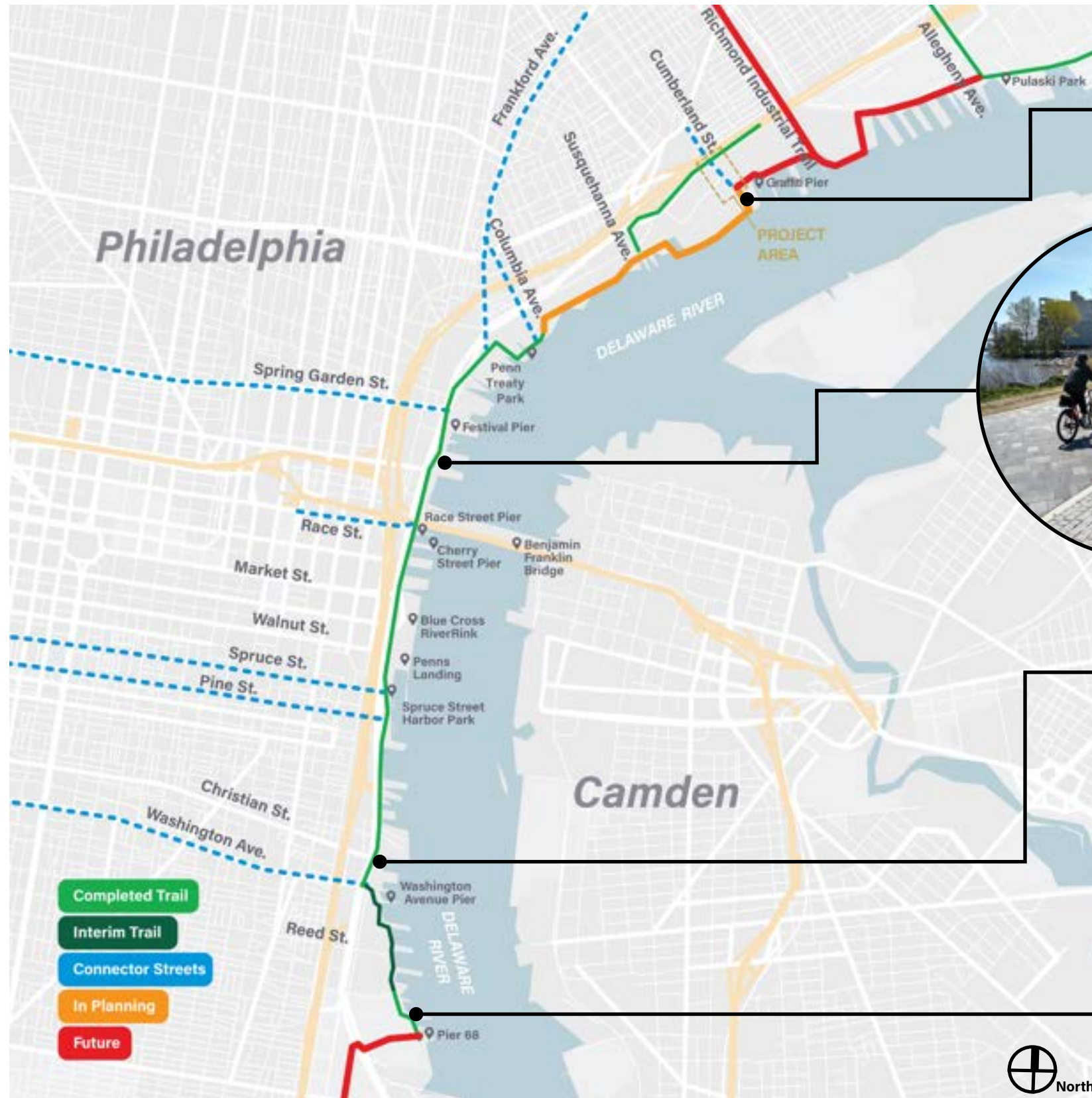

Trail & Connector Street Status & Project Goals



Project Goals:

- Engage and incorporate feedback from stakeholders and the public
- Coordinate with City, PennDOT, and property owners along Cumberland St. between I-95 and Beach St.
- Development of Designed Improvements:
 - Richmond St. & Cumberland St. intersection safety improvements
 - Landscape buffering and greening along Cumberland St.
 - Street lighting and pedestrian-scale trail lighting along Cumberland St.
 - Paved sidepath trail along Cumberland St. connecting to:
 - Ex. trail under I-95
 - Ex. trail along Northbank Development
 - Future Graffiti Pier Park
- Permitting with City and State agencies
- Bidding and construction of trail

Delaware River Trail & Connector Streets



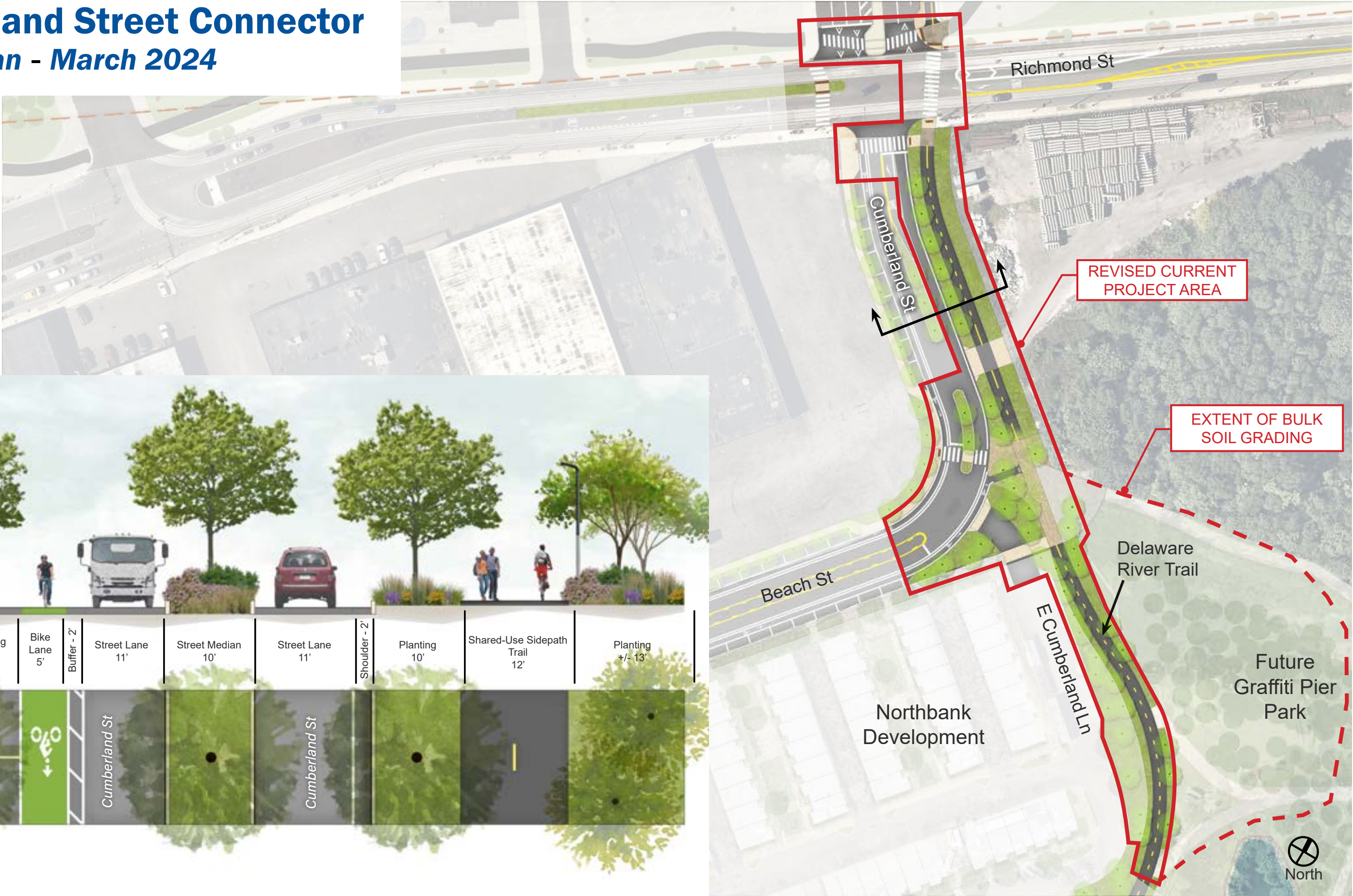

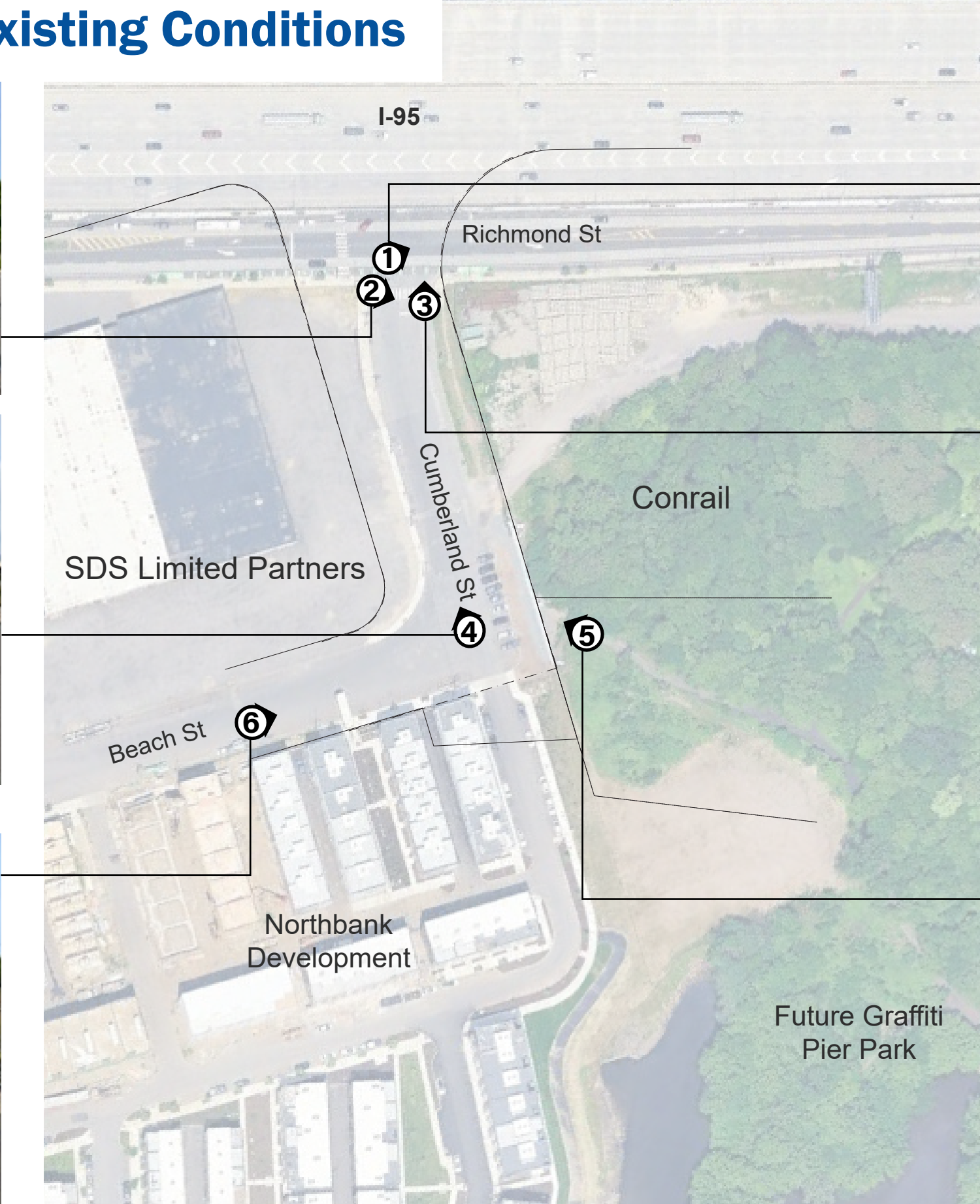

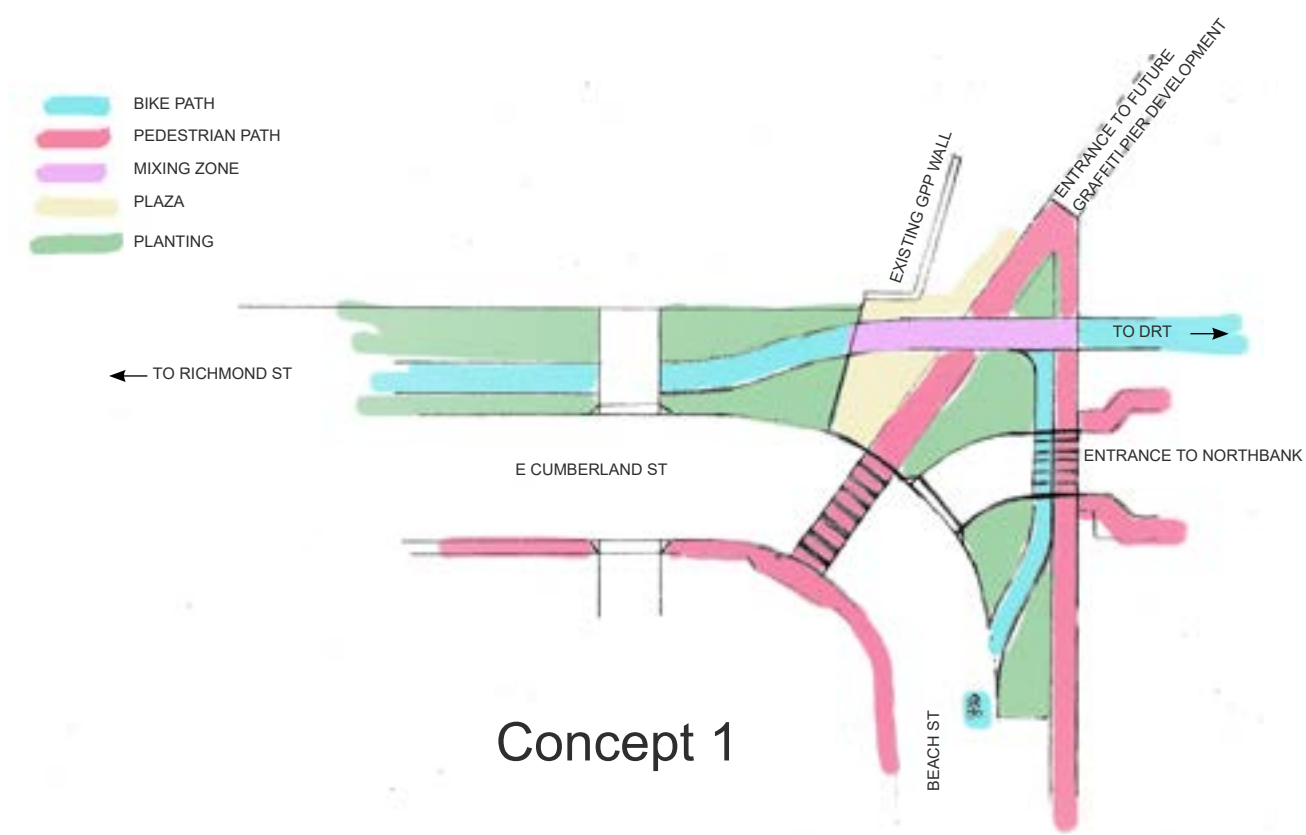

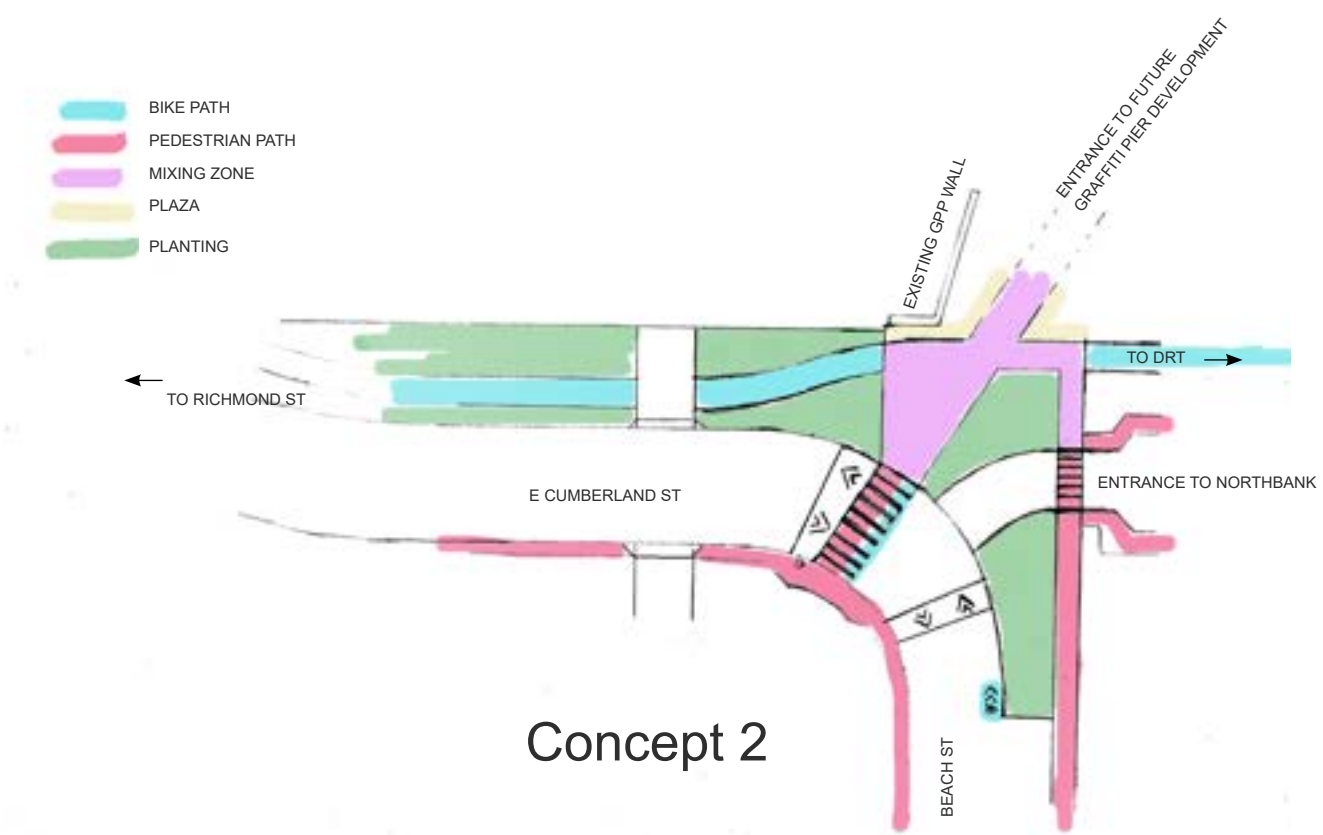
Cumberland Street - Existing Conditions



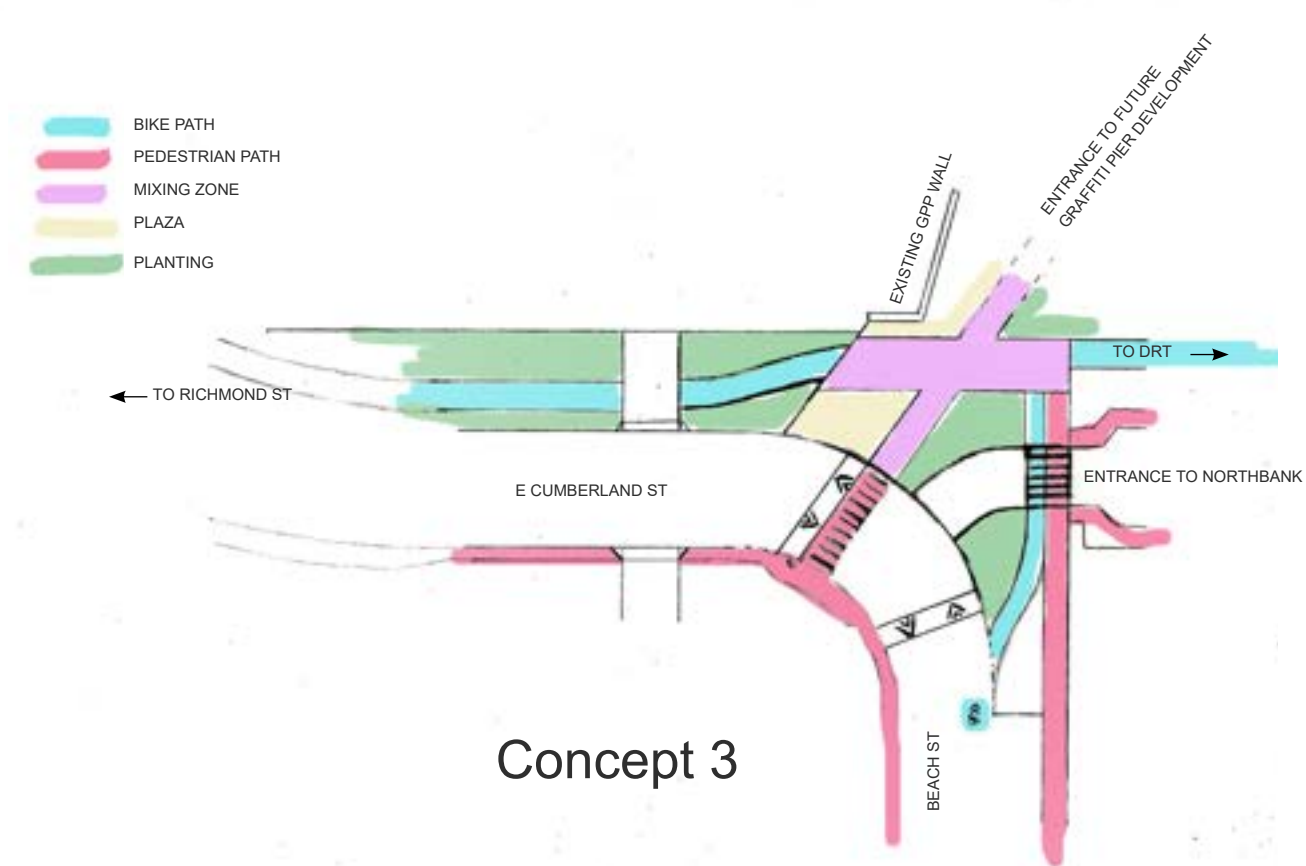

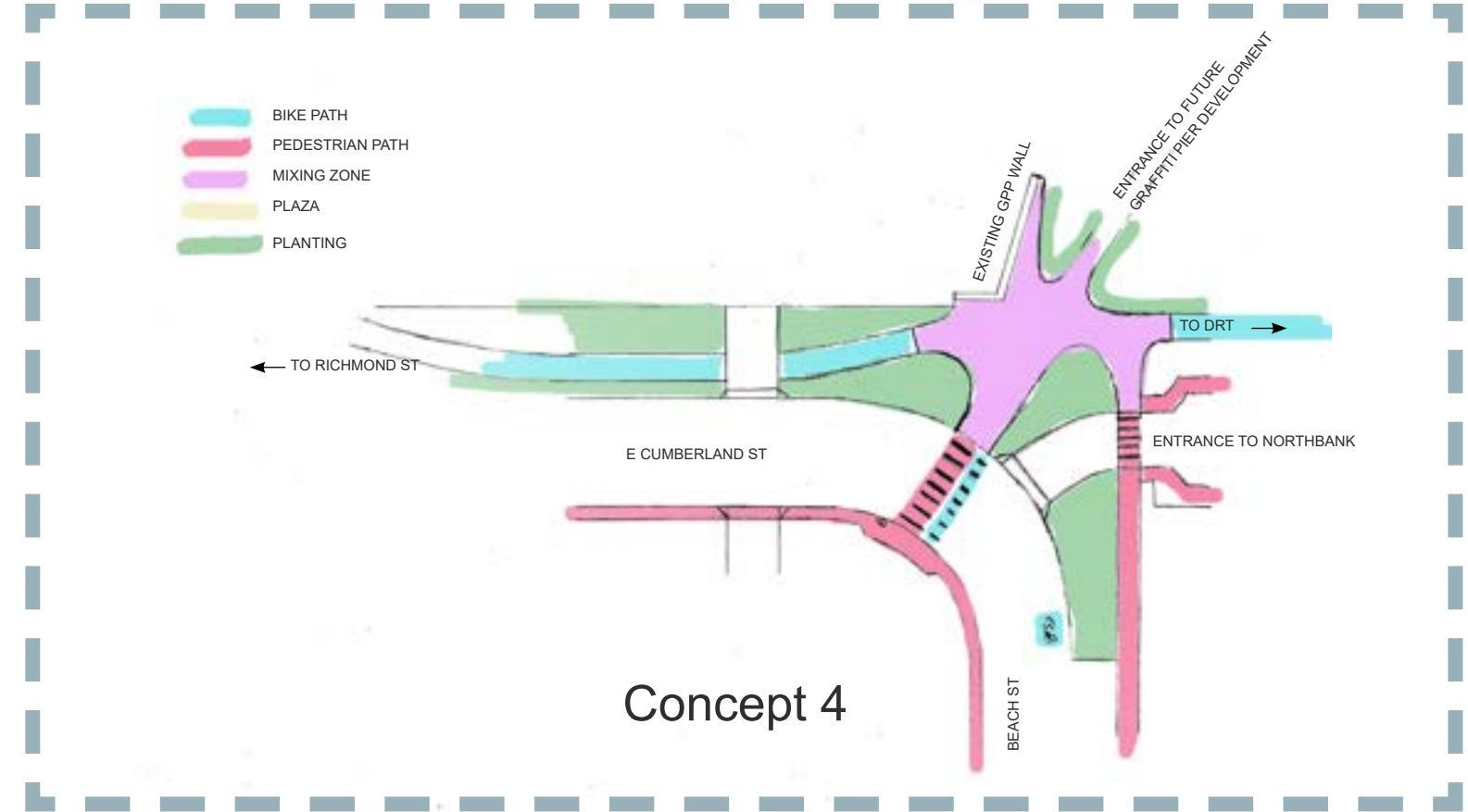

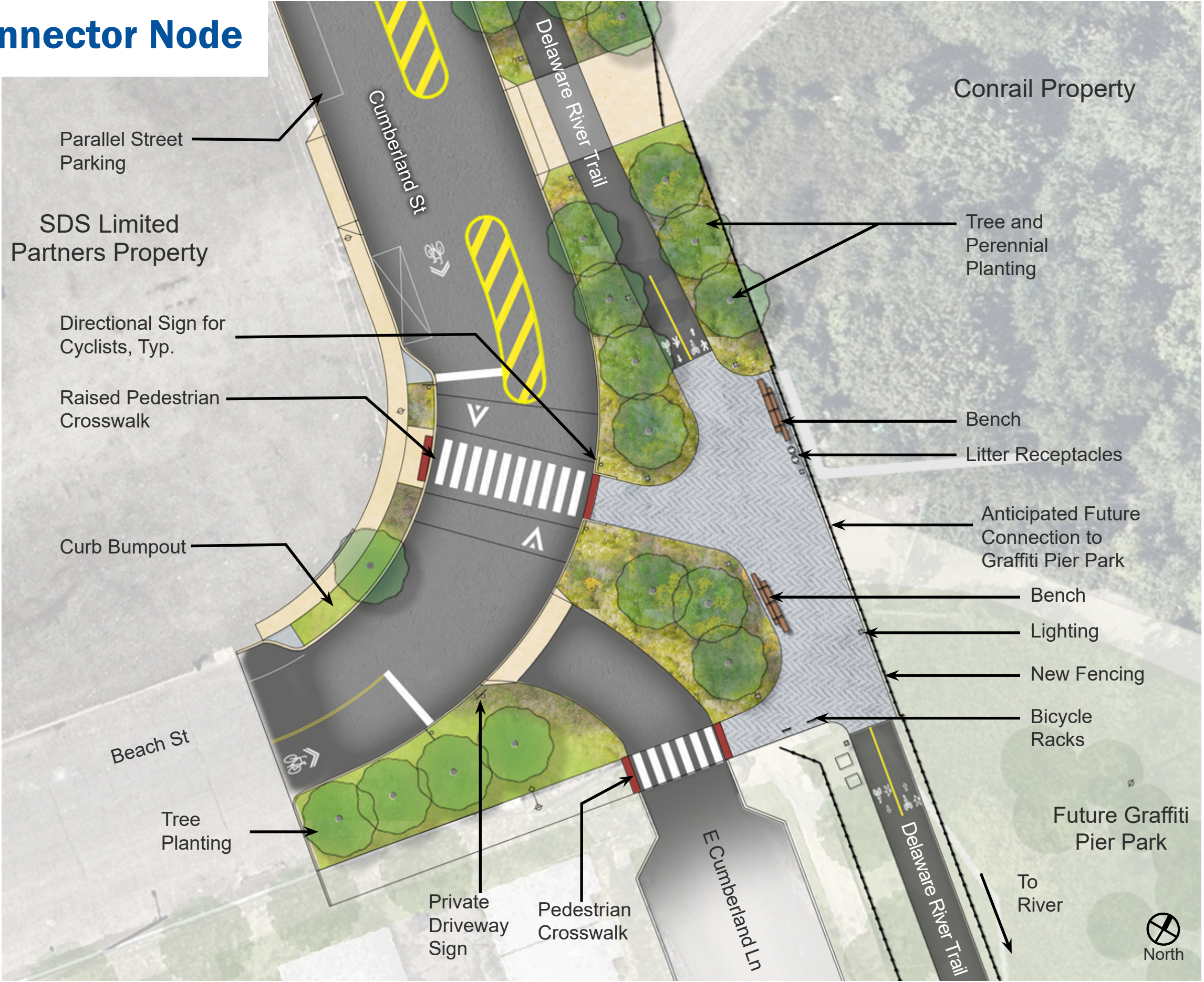

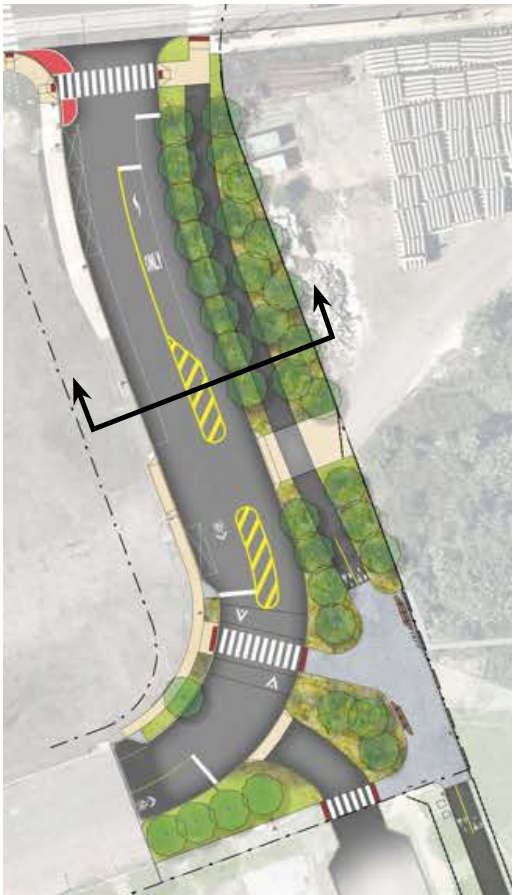

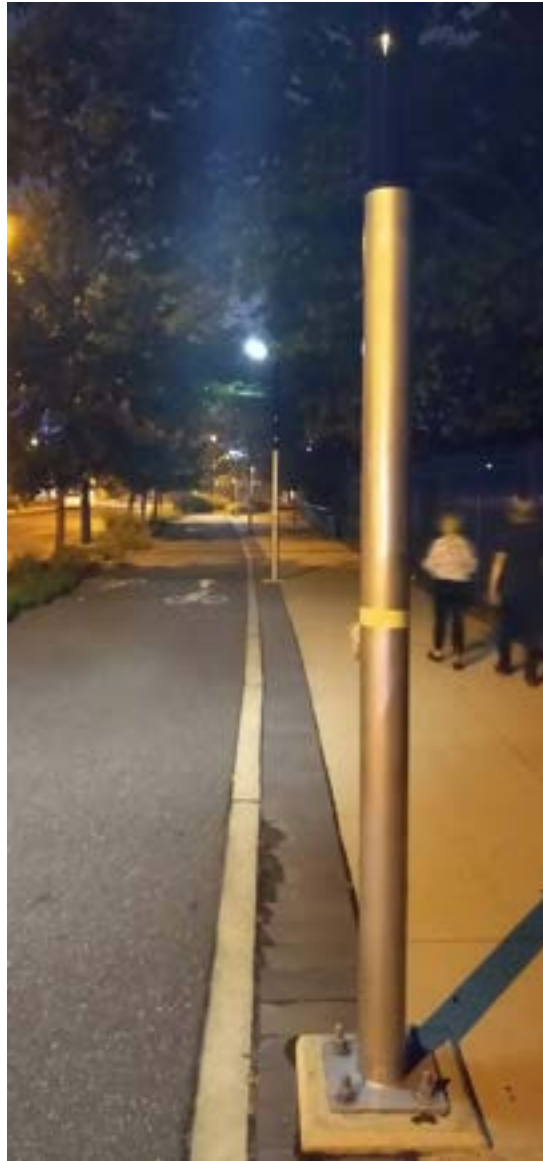

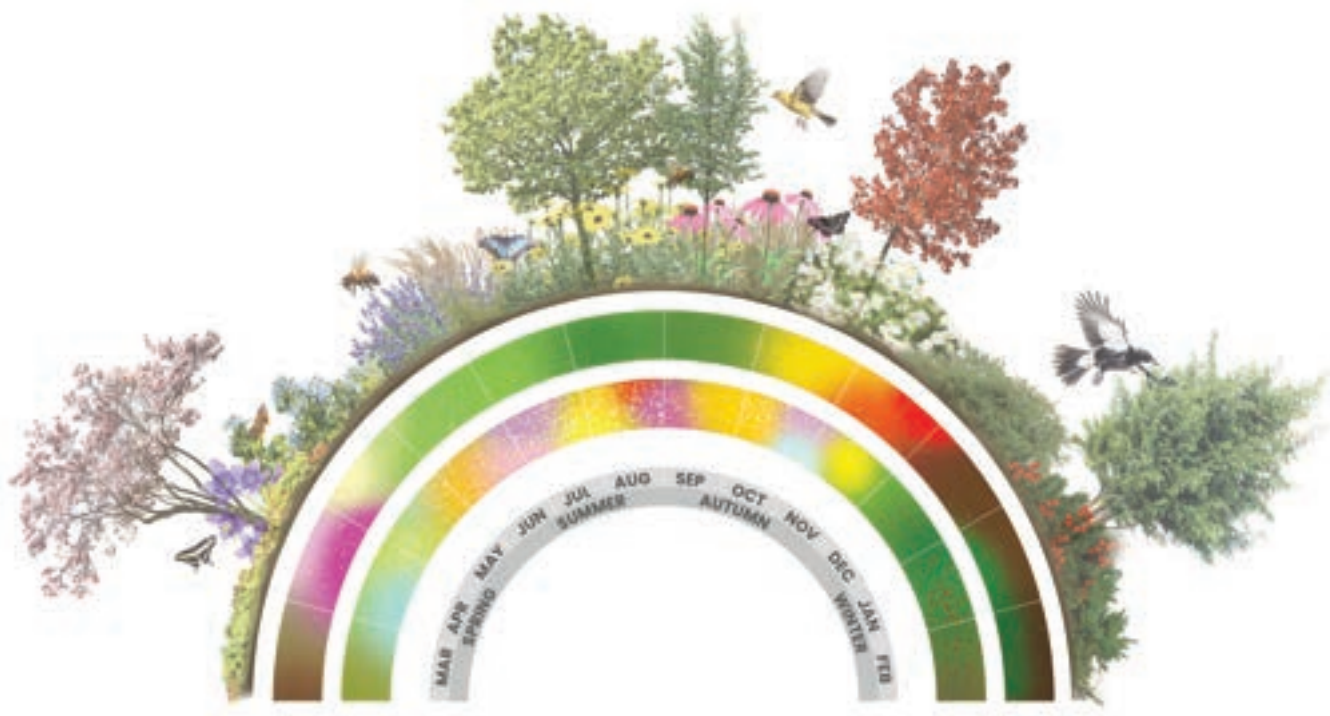
