The long-awaited **Penn's Landing Cap and Civic Space** is getting closer to making its debut. A game-changer for Philadelphia, this space will bridge the gap between Old City and the Waterfront with a robust public engagement process. Look for opportunities to let us know how you want to enjoy your reimagined waterfront.

Bike riders, runners, and all outdoor enthusiasts will be able to enjoy the expansion of the **Delaware River Trail**. Composed of three adjoining trails—the North Trail, the South Trail, and the Central Trail—these shared-use paths (complete with benches and ample lighting along the way) will be ideal for the safety of pedestrians and cyclists alike.

This spring, DRWC launched the Waterfront Arts Program, an exciting new initiative designed to bring high-quality permanent and temporary public art, events, and creative programming to the six-mile stretch of the Central Delaware River Waterfront from Allegheny to Oregon Avenues.

EVERYONE HAS A STORY TO TELL

Inspired by the Pont des Arts bridge in Paris, the Philadelphia Hope Fence was built and dedicated to the city of Philadelphia by Dan and Sarah Keating. Dan, Hilton Penn's Landing owner and developer, engineered the fence specifically to accommodate the weight of locks.

The Hope Fence is located at the Penn's Landing Promenade along the exterior of the Hilton Philadelphia at Penn's Landing.
